



AAM Supplier Anti-Corruption Acknowledgment

AAM's Compliance Department requires that all AAM suppliers/business partners execute the following acknowledgment:

- AAM is committed to complying with anti-corruption laws that prohibit bribes, kickbacks or other corrupt actions to obtain or retain business or obtain an improper advantage. All suppliers are expected to comply with applicable anti-corruption laws while conducting business on behalf of AAM. The undersigned supplier agrees to comply with these AAM expectations.
- AAM suppliers are prohibited from directly or indirectly receiving or offering any form of bribe, kickback or other corrupt payment, to or from AAM associates, public officials or other private or public actors. The undersigned supplier agrees to comply with these AAM expectations.
- The undersigned supplier agrees to comply with all applicable anti-corruption laws including, without limitation, the U.S. Foreign Corrupt Practices Act (FCPA) and the U.K. Bribery Act. The undersigned supplier certifies that it will not engage in any form of commercial bribery, nor bribery of any government official, nor bribery of any officer or employee of any state-owned entity.
- The undersigned supplier prohibits its subcontractors, vendors, agents or other associated third parties from receiving or offering any form of bribe, kickback or other corrupt payment, consistent with AAM's expectations as described in this document.
- The undersigned supplier acknowledges and certifies that:
 1. Supplier has received and reviewed the AAM Code of Business Conduct, the AAM Supplier Requirements Manual, and the AAM Anti-Corruption Policy.
 2. Supplier maintains a code of conduct and/or policies which prohibit commercial bribery and bribery of government officials, consistent with AAM's expectations as described in this document.
 3. Supplier grants AAM audit rights, including access to supplier's premises and books and records for the purpose of auditing supplier's compliance with this acknowledgment. Supplier will cooperate with AAM so as to facilitate AAM's audit, including, without limitation, by segregating and promptly producing such records as AAM may reasonably request, and otherwise making records and other materials accessible to AAM.
 4. AAM may terminate all or any part of its contract with supplier, without liability to supplier, if supplier breaches any term of this acknowledgment.
